Y _____ N _____</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> A methimazole trial should be conducted to assess the potential for unmasking renal disease that may have been obscured by the hyperthyroid state. Methimazole must be given at an adequate dose to induce a euthyroid state for at least 2-4 weeks followed by retesting of T4 (to confirm euthyroid state) and a concurrent renal profile with urine specific gravity.</p>

If the results still support hyperthyroidism, the patient can be scheduled for I-131 therapy. If the Total T4 is low normal (or high normal with normal free T4 by ED), keep the cat off methimazole until the values again support hyperthyroidism rechecking every 2-4 weeks.</p>
